What should I achieve?

<p>ISSUES ALL should know some reasons why people follow Christianity. MOST should understand why Christianity is important to some people. SOME might judge the effects Christianity has on a person's life.</p>	<p>LIFESTANCE ALL should show knowledge and respect for some Christian beliefs and practices. MOST should understand the value of beliefs for Christians and for themselves. SOME could compare their own beliefs and practices with that of Christians.</p>
<p>RELIGION ALL should know some of the main beliefs of Christianity. MOST should recognise the link between the main beliefs and the life and words of Jesus Christ. SOME could understand why the main beliefs and practices are important for Christians.</p>	<p>MEANING ALL should know what parables are and understand one of Jesus'. MOST should explain why Jesus and Christians used parables. SOME could judge the value of parables for Christians today.</p>

MOST Year 7 student's learning should reflect a level between **STEP3** and **STEP4** in RELIGIOUS EDUCATION. (See Agreed Syllabus for details)

Homework: Learning will include opportunities to investigate things outside of the classroom, including investigation into Jesus' life and teachings and miracles today.
