



Our expectations are that students will follow the school rules and the behaviour policy which underpins them. When this does not happen, students may be issued with a detention. The table below sets out the detention structure.

The Department for Education stipulates that we do not require parental permission to impose a detention and, whilst we always strive to provide advance notice, this is also not a requirement.
